



Aberdeen Country Park Aberdeen Tree Walk (AB)

Introduction

The Aberdeen Tree Walk, another pleasant route, starts at the country park entrance on Aberdeen Reservoir Road. This 2.5 KM trail ends at Wan Chai Gap. With interpretation sign for 20 tree species, it is an ideal choice for those who wish to learn more about the forms and features of Hong Kong's wild flora.

Transportation:

- Take bus or mini-bus and get off at Yue Kwong Road bus/mini-bus terminus. Then walk along the Aberdeen Reservoir Road uphill for about 5 minutes to the entrance of the picnic area for the physically disabled, where the starting point of the Tree Walk is located. Bus/GMB routes are:
- Citybus
 - Route 7 Central (Outlying Island Ferry Pier) – Shek Pai Wan
 - Route 76 Causeway Bay ((Moreton Terrace) – Shek Pai Wan Estate
- New World First Bus
 - Route 95 Ape Lei Chau Estate – Shek Pai Wan
 - Route 971 Hoi Lai Estate – Aberdeen (Shek Pai Wan)
- GMB
 - Route 4B Wanchai Tam Sun Thomson Road – Aberdeen Nam Ning Street
 - Route 4C Causeway Bay Cannon Street – Aberdeen Nam Ning Street
 - Route 4S Aberdeen Sai On Street – Aberdeen Shek Pai Wan
 - Route 35M Wanchai Johnston Road – Aberdeen Tung Sing Road

Walk from Wanchai Gap Garden to Stubbs Road to take the following bus routes to depart:

- New World First Bus
 - Route 15 The Peak – Central
 - Route 15B The Peak – MTR Tin Hau Station (Available on Sundays and Public Holidays only)

Time Required:

- 1 - 1.5 hours

Difficulty level:

- Low

- All year round
